MISSION OF THE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The **Filipino Chamber of Commerce of Hawaii Foundation** promotes the pursuit of higher education by awarding scholarship grants to deserving Hawaii high school seniors.

AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIPS

The Chamber's Scholarship Program is funded from the proceeds of the Farmers Insurance Hawaii presents Filipino Chamber of Commerce of Hawaii Foundation Annual Scholarship Golf Tournament.

For 2010, approximately \$16,000.00 in scholarships is expected to be awarded, with one (1) award of at least \$4,000.00 to the top scholar (designated as the Farmers Insurance Hawaii/Filipino Chamber Foundation Scholar) and four (4) awards of at least \$3,000.00 each..

ELIGIBILITY

- Applicant must be a Hawaii resident
- Applicant must be a high school senior graduating in 2010 with a cumulative high school grade point average of at least 3.5 on a 4.0 scale
- Applicant must be accepted to a four year college or university
- Applicant must complete the application and provide all required documents by the stated deadline. The Scholarship Judges reserve the right to request supplemental materials from any applicant.

SELECTION CRITERIA

The Scholarship Judges' decision will be based on the applicant's academic record, activities, awards, and honors, and a one-page short essay. **Please note the one page limitation for the essay is strictly enforced and your application will not be forwarded to the Scholarship Judges.** All decisions by the Scholarship Judges are final.

DEADLINE

The completed application and all supporting documents must be **RECEIVED** (not postmarked) in the Filipino Chamber Foundation's office at the above-stated address, no later than 5:00PM on Wednesday, March 31, 2010.

ABSOLUTELY NO EXTENSIONS OR EXCEPTIONS WILL BE GRANTED.
